

# LOUDON COUNTY ELECTION NOTICE

Pursuant to TCA §2-12-111(a) notice is hereby given to the Voters of Loudon County that Loudon County will hold a

## Federal/State Primary Election & Loudon County General Election August 4, 2016.

The Republican and Democratic nominees shall appear on the November Federal/State General Election ballot.

### Offices to be on the Federal/State Primary ballot for both the Republican and Democratic parties' nominees:

United States House of Representatives- 2nd Congressional District  
State of Tennessee House of Representatives- 21st and 32nd District seats

### Offices to be on the County General ballot:

#### These will only be on the August County General ballot.

9th Judicial District Criminal Court Judge- To fill the unexpired term of 6 years until August 31, 2022  
The 9th Judicial District is comprised of Loudon, Meigs, Morgan and Roane Counties)

(Loudon County School Board is a non-partisan election)

Loudon County School Board 1st District- Seat A and B

Loudon County School Board 3rd District- 1 seat

Loudon County School Board 5th District- Seat A and B

Loudon County School Board 7th District- 1 seat

- The first day to pick-up a petition for the Federal/State Offices, the 9th Judicial District Criminal Court Judge and the Loudon County School Board seats will be **Friday, January 8, 2016**.  
**Petitions may be picked-up at the Loudon County Election Commission Office @ 100 River Road , Suite 108, Loudon, Tennessee 37774**
- Qualifying deadline for these offices will be **12:00 Noon, Thursday, April 7, 2016** for all Republican, Democratic and Independent candidates.
- A Loudon County resident desiring to run for the Office of 9th Judicial District Criminal Court Judge must file ORIGINAL qualifying paperwork in Loudon County Election Commission Office, and certified copies of the original qualifying paperwork in Meigs, Morgan and Roane County Election Commission Offices before the **12:00 Noon, Thursday, April 7, 2016** qualifying deadline.
- The withdrawal deadline will be **12:00 Noon, Thursday, April 14, 2016**.
- The last day to register to vote in person or by mail postmarked for the August 4, 2016 election is **Tuesday, July 5, 2016**.
- The first day for armed forces, spouses and overseas voters to request an absentee ballot for this election is **January 1, 2016**.
- The first day to request an absentee ballot other than armed forces and overseas voters is **May 6, 2016**.

### Public Notice for Elderly Voters or Voters with Disabilities

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible may vote early by absentee ballot or at the Election Commission on Election Day. TCA 2-3-109 (e) (1)

If the voter chooses to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, they must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office **no later than July 25, 2016** (ten days prior to the election), stating that their designated voting location is not accessible.

### PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR VOTERS:

**If you are voting in person during Early Voting or on Election Day**, a Federal or State of Tennessee Government issued **photo ID** is required for voting, unless an exception applies. College student ID's and out-of-state photo ID's will not be accepted. Valid forms of acceptable identification include a Tennessee driver license with your photo, United States passport, Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID, Photo ID issued by the federal government, United States military ID including a Veteran Identification Card, and a Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo.
